ALL ENTRIES CLOSE Friday 4th February 2022 at 4.00pm

Judging commences at 10.am Saturday 19th February 2022

Please note that Show Dates or Classes may change due to restrictions surrounding Covid-19. Please follow our Facebook page or Website for updates.

General Rules and Regulations for the governance and conduct of the Franklin A & P Society shall be those issued by the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ (Inc) and it shall be deemed as if they had been printed in full in this Schedule. Any exhibitor not sure of the conditions should get in touch with the Secretary.

The Franklin A & P Society may publish the names of winners.

All sheep entered in the show must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor.

Sheep must not be housed for more than 48 hours prior to the Show. All sheep must be shorn on or after 1st July 2021 unless otherwise stated.

All sheep entered in the show must be from a flock currently accredited Brucellosis free. Copies of Brucellosis Certificates must accompany entries.

Sheep must be exhibited in NATURAL CONDITION

PRIZE MONEY

The Franklin A & P Society will not be offering prize money in any section. Each section is a Ribbon Day event only.

PRIVACY ACT

The Society holds records and names and addresses of all members and exhibitors and will publish these as necessary for media show reports unless advised.

PROTESTS:

All protests are to be lodged at the Secretaries office within 30 minutes of the event. Protests must be in writing and accompanied by a \$50.00 cash deposit. This will be refunded if the protest is upheld. Where necessary, the Franklin A & P Society will adjudicate in all matters other than judging and such a decision shall be final.

DISCLAIMER:

It may be necessary to make changes to the programme, prizes or judges because of circumstances beyond our control. No correspondence will be entered into.

SPORTSMANSHIP:

The purpose of our show is to provide our community and visiting competitors the opportunity to have an enjoyable day of fun and competition, therefore any person or persons who verbally or otherwise abuses fellow competitors, stewards, judges or show officials may be asked, at the discretion of the Show Committee, to leave the Showgrounds.

The John Allen Trophy awarded to the Champion Ewe is awarded in rotation. Rotation for 2022: Suffolk.

The Governor Generals Crook awarded to the Best Ram / Lamb is awarded in rotation. Rotation for 2022: Suffolk.

The Harris Memorial Cup for Perpetual Competition is awarded to the exhibitor gaining most points in the Sheep Section. Exhibitors cannot gain multiple points by exhibiting more than one breed.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Friday 4th February 2022

No late entries will be accepted.

Animals may be substituted but only into the same class – the Secretaries office is to be notified by 5.00pm on the day before competition.

No refunds will be given for non-participation after payment has been made.

Ground Fee \$10.00 per Sheep. All Sheep on the grounds must have paid a Ground Fee.

No sheep are to be removed from the show before 4pm Saturday without the permission of the Chief Steward.

EXHIBITOR PASSES

Each Exhibitor will receive 2(two) Exhibitor's Passes – one for themselves and one for a supporter / assistant. All Exhibitors who can't present passes at the gate will be charged normal entry charges and there will be no refunds.

EVENT CANCELLATION

If the show is abandoned or postponed due to any reason beyond the control of the Show Organiser, the Show Organiser is under no obligation to refund in whole or any part, any payments made by the exhibitors. Any refund will be made at the discretion of the Franklin Agricultural and Pastoral Society.
