# RULES AND REGULATIONS

ALL ENTRIES CLOSE Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> February 2026 at 4.00pm

Judging commences at 10.am Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2026

## CHIEF STEWARD: Carol Steele

General Rules and Regulations for the governance and conduct of the Franklin A & P Society shall be those issued by the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ (Inc) and it shall be deemed as if they had been printed in full in this Schedule. Any exhibitor not sure of the conditions should get in touch with the Secretary.

The Franklin A & P Society may publish the names of winners.

All sheep entered in the show must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor.

Sheep must not be housed for more than 48 hours prior to the Show. All sheep must be shorn on or after 1<sup>st</sup> July 2025 unless otherwise stated.

All sheep entered in the show must be from a flock currently accredited Brucellosis free. Copies of Brucellosis Certificates must accompany entries.

**Sheep must be exhibited in NATURAL CONDITION**

## PRIZE MONEY

1<sup>st</sup> \$20.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$15.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$10.00 (except where otherwise stated).

The Society reserves the right to substitute advertised prize money with either Product or Vouchers. The Society reserves the right to provide lower prize money amounts if there are three entries or less in any Class. The Society reserves the right to combine or substitute Classes if there are low entry numbers in individual Classes.

## PRIVACY ACT

The Society holds records and names and addresses of all members and exhibitors and will publish these as necessary for media show reports unless advised.

## PROTESTS:

All protests are to be lodged at the Secretaries office within 30 minutes of the event. Protests must be in writing and accompanied by a \$50.00 cash deposit. This will be refunded if the protest is upheld. Where necessary, the Franklin A & P Society will adjudicate in all matters other than judging and such a decision shall be final.

## DISCLAIMER:

It may be necessary to make changes to the programme, prizes or judges because of circumstances beyond our control. No correspondence will be entered into.

## CHANGES TO THE SCHEDULE:

The Society reserves the right to alter or amend the Schedule as they see fit, with no recourse to the Society.

## SPORTSMANSHIP:

The purpose of our show is to provide our community and visiting competitors the opportunity to have an enjoyable

day of fun and competition. Any person or persons who verbally or otherwise abuses fellow competitors, stewards, judges or show officials may be asked, at the discretion of the Show Committee, to leave the Showgrounds.

The Society will not be held responsible for loss or damage to Competitors or their property whilst on the grounds. The Society will not be responsible for any claim. The Society will not be held responsible for any accident that may occur in competition or that may occur from machine or other exhibits or plant belonging to Competitors or the Society and it is a condition of entry that such Competitor or visitor shall hold the Society blameless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings from any accidents caused.

No late entries will be accepted.

Animals may be substituted but only into the same class – the Secretaries office is to be notified by 5.00pm on the day before competition.

No refunds will be given for non-participation after payment has been made.
