General rules and regulations for the governance and conduct of the Show shall be the same as the rules and regulations as issued by the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ (Inc) and it shall be deemed as if they have been printed in full in this Schedule. If any Competitor is not sure of the conditions they should get in touch with the Secretary.

All Cattle Breeds must be RAS Affiliated to compete for placings of 1st to 3rd.

NO EXCEPTIONS to the below:

- All cattle must be led with a nose clip
- All cattle on the grounds must be tied in stalls with both a halter and collar.
- If cattle are found without this, you will be unable to compete.
- Any cattle coming onto the Showgrounds that have been bucket or bottle fed by whole milk must supply a current and clear milk test from each milk supplier.
- All cattle being shown must be registered with their Society or Club. Owners must be Members if that is what is required of that Society to be shown.
- Cattle to be entered with NAIT # and Farm Name

PRIZE MONEY

1st \$20.00, 2nd \$15.00, 3rd \$10.00

(Except where otherwise stated)

The Society reserves the right to substitute advertised prize money with either product or vouchers.

No prize money will be awarded unless the class is completed, as per the conditions of the class.

Where there are fewer than three entries in any class only half prize money may be paid.

The stewards at the show may provisionally announce point's prizes.

PRIVACY ACT

The Society holds and records the names and addresses of all members, competitors and exhibitors and will publish these as necessary for media show reports unless advised.

ENTRY FEES

Unless otherwise stated, All Breeds Classes \$12.00

GROUND FEES:

Ground Fee \$10.00 per animal (capped at \$20.00). All Beef Cattle on the grounds must have paid a Ground Fee.

NOTE: The Society reserves the right to merge classes if there are insufficient entries, and to amend or alter the program as it sees fit.

ENTRIES CLOSE 18th FEBRUARY 2026

No late entries will be accepted. Animals may be substituted but only into the same class - the Office is to be notified by 5.00pm on the day before competition.

No refunds will be given for non-participation after payment has been made.

EXHIBITOR PASSES

Each Competitor is entitled to entry to the Show for themselves and a supporter / assistant. All Competitors who cannot present proof of entry at the gate will be charged normal entry charges and there will be no refunds.

Competitors who wish to arrive on Friday evening should advise the office when placing entries for the Show, to facilitate access to stalls.

Cattle remaining overnight must have neck ties in addition to halters.

OWNERSHIP

All cattle must be the property of the Competitor or be a leased animal with an official lease registered with the Breed society or the RAS.

All Beef Cattle must be stalled by 8.45am on the Saturday of the show

FOR ANY CATTLE PURCHASED AND BROUGHT ONTO YOUR PROPERTY IN THE LAST TWELVE (12) MONTHS, YOU MUST SUPPLY A COPY OF THE ASD FORM THAT ACCOMPANIED THAT ANIMAL AND A COPY OF THE NAIT TRANSFER.

ANIMAL REGISTRATION

All cattle entered in the Breed Classes must be entered or eligible for registration in the recognised Herd Books of the affiliated Breed Societies.

CATTLE FRAMES

Space for frames must be booked with entries.

CATALOGUE NUMBERS

All cattle shall wear a catalogue number when parading in the ring for judging, but no animal shall wear an award ribbon or card awarded in a previous Class while in the ring for judging in any special class or for the Championship awards.

Failure to return catalogue numbers to the designated Steward will result in charge of \$10.00 being levied.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

All cattle entered in group or special classes must be exhibited in open Classes.

SHOWING CONDITIONS

No badges or ribbons other than those won at this Show shall be displayed either on the stalls or in the Cattle Parade.

Bulls 12 months and over MUST be rung and led with two leads, with one lead attached to the permanent Ring.

It is compulsory that all beef must led by a halter and nose clip.

If individual breed numbers are sufficient, a separate breed section may be accommodated at the discretion of the Show Committee. The Committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes in breed rings. Where there are insufficient entries, rings or classes may be combined or deleted. See each section.

POINTS

1st = 6, 2nd = 4, 3rd = 2. In the event of a tie a count back will take place.

CHAMPIONS AND RESERVE CHAMPIONS

Champions will be selected in the following order: First prize winner in all Classes shall parade before the Judge for his selection of Champion. As soon as the selection is made the second prize winner in the Class in which the Champion is first will parade with the others for Reserve Champion.

TB POLICY

All Cattle entered for a showing or exhibiting must be from a current TB Clear Status Herd . A copy of the current TB Test Allocation Certificate must accompany the entry forms. The Society must be notified at the time of entry of any testing to be carried out after the closing date of entries or of any potential TB issues that may arise after entries are submitted. Owners entering cattle must sign any declaration printed on the entry form. There are two documents required:-

- TB test certificate. For animals from a Declared Movement Control area - all animals aged 3 months or older are to be TB tested and have a clear test within 60 days prior to being moved to the Show. All other animals must be from a herd that is up to date with its current TB testing routine.
- TB Animal Status Declaration Card. This is a legal requirement for all animals being moved.
- All animals entered must be accompanied in transit by a signed and dated TB Animal Status Declaration Card showing a TB Clear Status in accordance with the present legislation.

Animal individual numbers must be included on the TB test sheet. These cards must be carried on day of Show and may be inspected at the loading area.

NAIT

A NAIT approved RFID tag will be mandatory for all movements of cattle, including day old calves. NAIT approved RFID cattle tags are white only. Please do not remove tags if cattle are identified with Animal Health Board or MINDA tags.

PROTESTS

All protests are to be lodged at the Secretaries office within 30 minutes of the event. Protests must be in writing and accompanied by a \$50.00 cash deposit. This will be refunded

if the protest is upheld. Where necessary, the Franklin A & P Society will adjudicate in all matters other than judging and such a decision shall be final.

DISCLAIMER

It may be necessary to make changes to the programme, prizes or judges because of circumstances beyond our control. No correspondence will be entered into.

SPORTSMANSHIP

The purpose of our Show is to provide our community and visiting Competitors the opportunity to have an enjoyable day of fun and competition, therefore any person or persons who verbally or otherwise abuses fellow Competitors, Stewards, Judges or Show Officials may be asked, at the discretion of the Show Committee, to leave the Showgrounds.

INSURANCE

The Society will not be held liable for loss or damage to Competitors or their property whilst on the grounds. The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may occur in competition or that may occur from machinery or other exhibits or plant belonging to Competitors or the Society and it is a condition of entry that such Competitor or visitor shall hold the Society blameless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings from any accidents caused.

ARREARS

Any Competitor found to be in arrears with any other affiliated Society may be refused entry to the Show.

EVENT CANCELLATION

If the show is abandoned or postponed due to any reason beyond the control of the Show Organiser, the Show Organiser is under no obligation to refund in whole or in part, any payments made by Competitors. Any refund will be made at the discretion of the Society.
